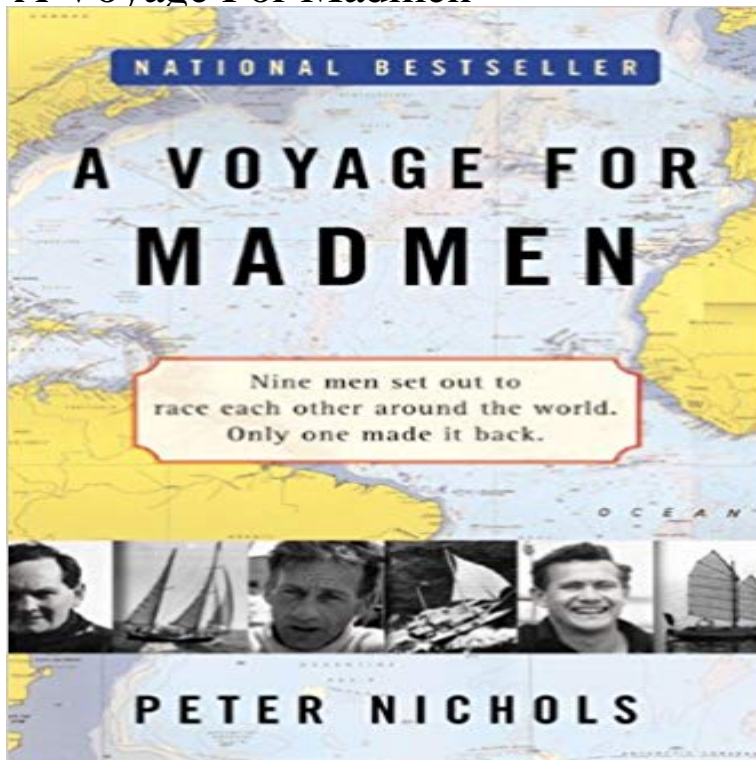


# A Voyage For Madmen
