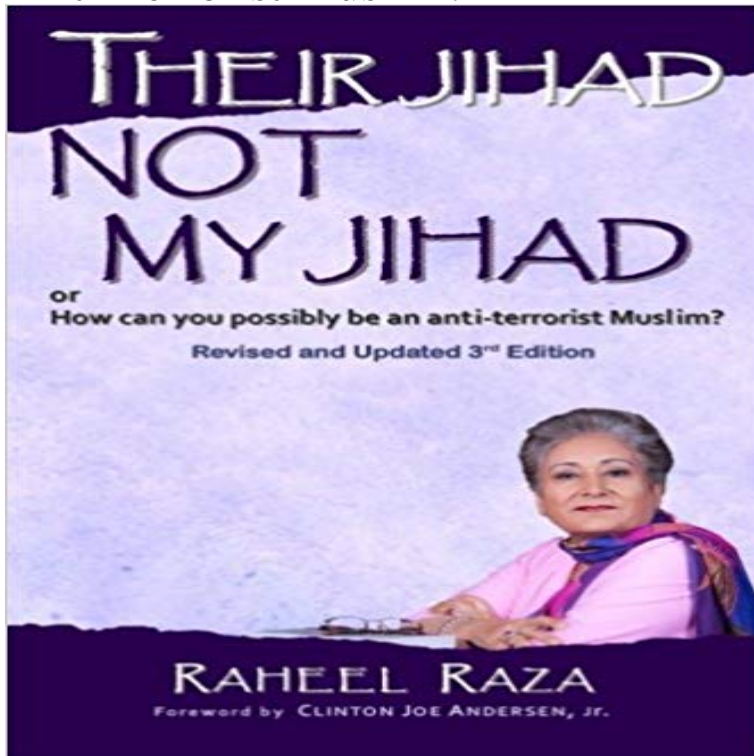


Their Jihad NOT My Jihad: Or How Can You Possibly be an Anti-Terrorist Muslim?
