


Prophet Muhammad as the Exalted Ruler of Arabian Peninsula

He did not take any state help though many a time fire did not light in his house and he had to sleep hungry and very often he had to face dark nights due to paucity of the burning oil. He wore no crown, had no throne, no courtiers, no fort and fortresses, no kingly robes and no glamorous paraphernalia. He ruled from the mudded floor of the Mosque and when he died, his august body was shrouded in three white sahooli cotton clothes which

had neither head cover nor casing. This unique ruler influenced the course of human history so much that historians pronounced him as the greatest man of all times. When he died in 632 he was the undisputed and the most effective ruler of Arabian Peninsula. He was not only a most influential, remarkable and exceptional genius of all times but a rare phenomenon on earth, walking in flesh and blood, and having maximum impact through ages.
