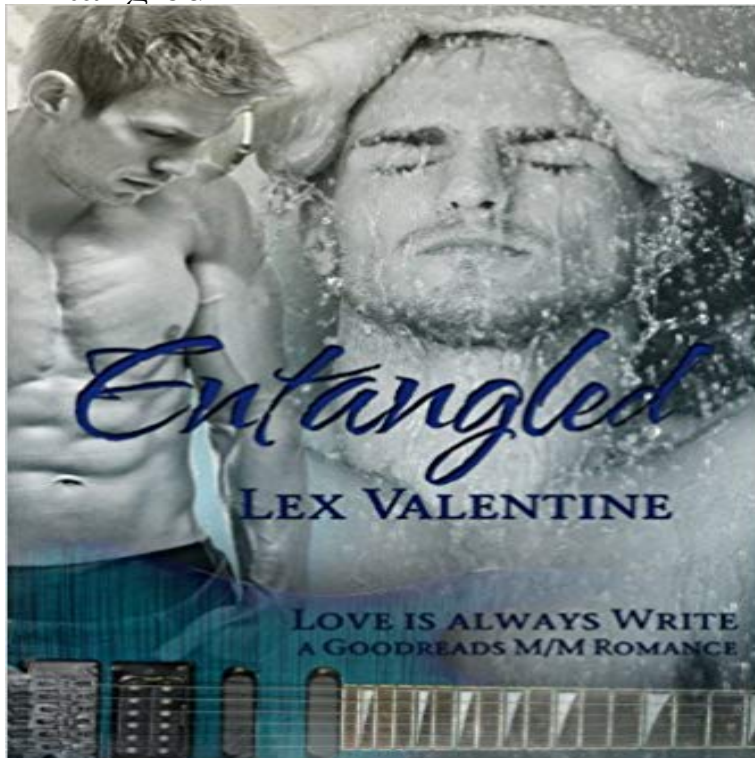


Entangled
