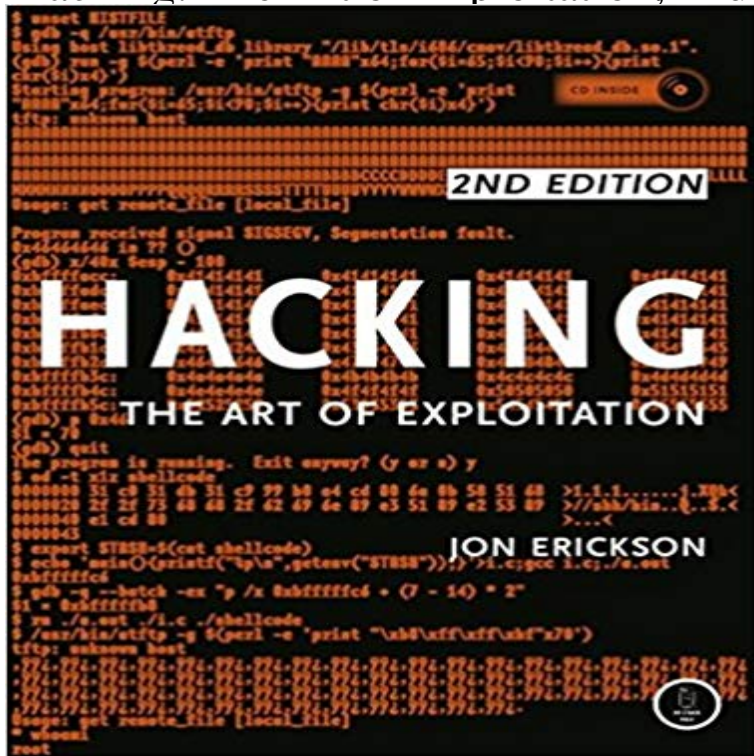


Hacking: The Art of Exploitation, 2nd Edition
