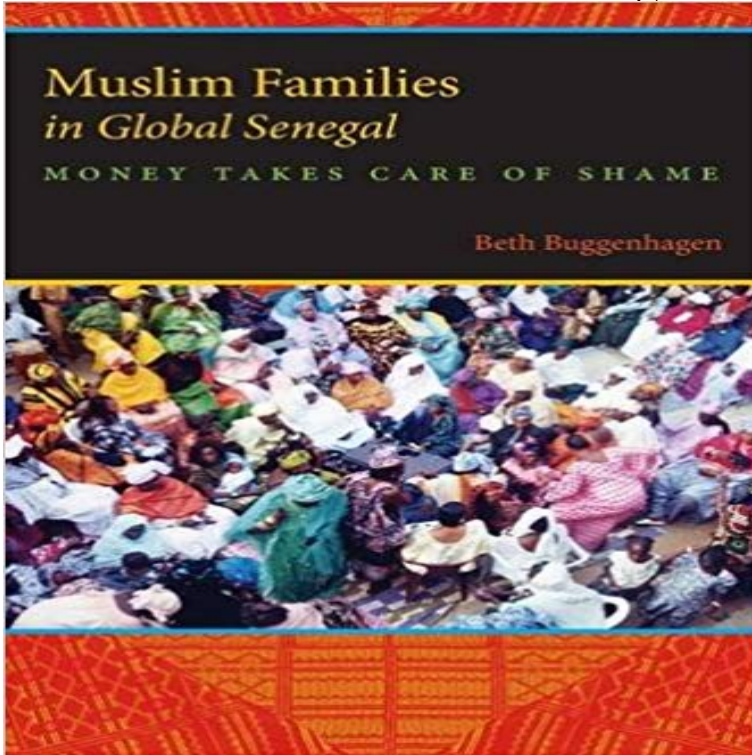


Muslim Families in Global Senegal: Money Takes Care of Shame
