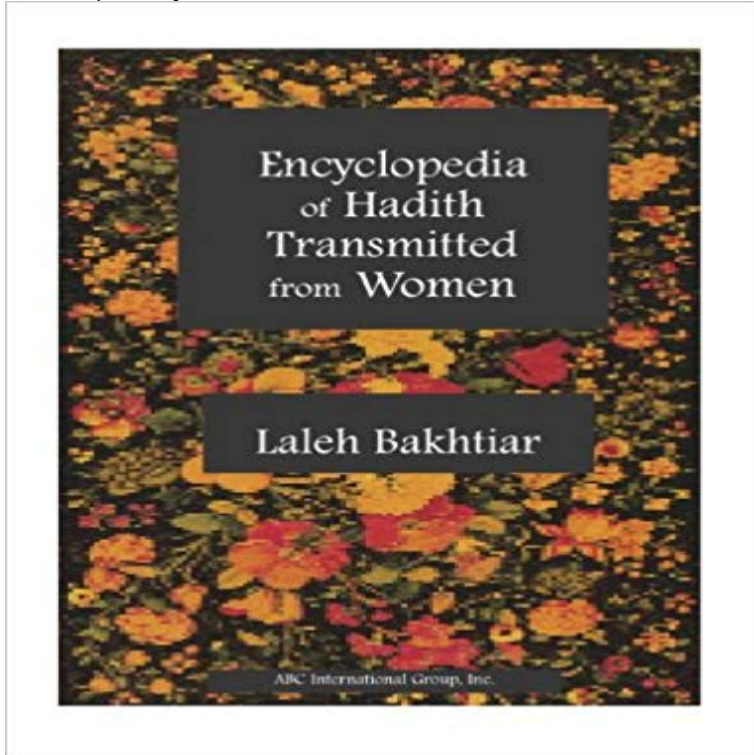


Encyclopedia of Hadith Transmitted from Women
