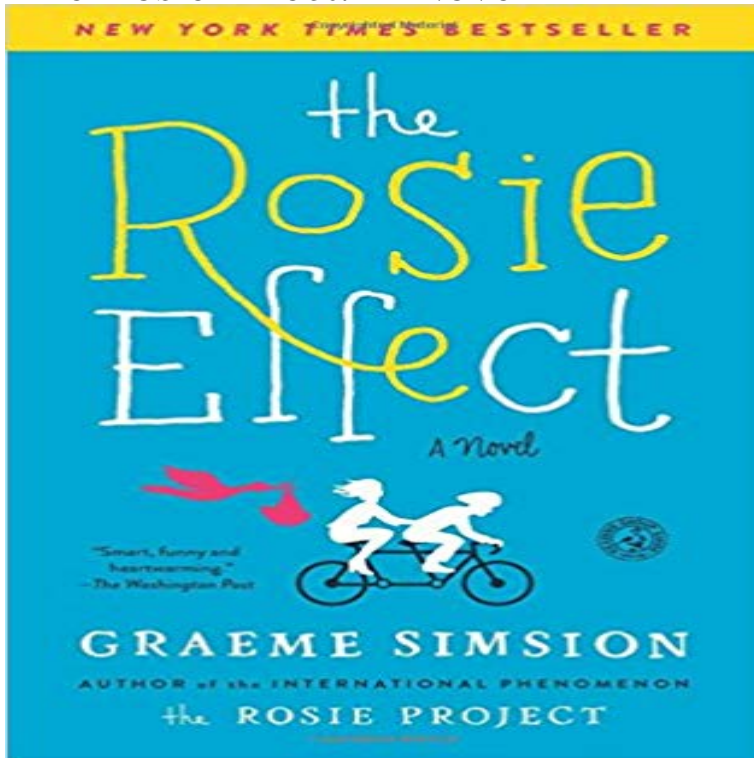


The Rosie Effect: A Novel
